TRAINING & CERTIFICATION

Training and certification starts with the ACCDN Designation, made up of 2 courses:

Dry Needling Level 1

Using the trigger point approach, DN1
teaches needling techniques for muscles in
the posterior and lateral hip, leg, and
shoulder to address treatment of conditions
such as strain of hip flexors, rotators,
piriformis syndrome, hamstring strain,
Achille's tendinitis, strain from immobilization
in casts, posterior rotator cuff, ankle
strain/sprain, shin splints, and knee strain.

Dry Needling Level 2

After some experience from DN1, DN2 moves into more dangerous areas of the body, teaching muscles in the lumbar spine/anterior hip, cervical spine and scapular region, scapulohumeral region/rotator cuff, scapulothoracic region, chest and arms.
