This two day course for physiotherapists is designed to enhance the clinician's understanding of shoulder anatomy, pathology, conservative treatment, surgical options and post-operative management. Learning opportunities will include a guided cadaver walk-through surgery, participation in a fresh-frozen cadaver dissection lab, as well as a variety of lectures and practical sessions.

Objectives

- Review and develop a thorough understanding of shoulder anatomy
- Improve clinical reasoning skills related to the assessment and treatment of various shoulder conditions
- Rationalize exercise prescription and improve manual therapy skills for the shoulder girdle and thoracic spine.
- Improve understanding of the medical management of shoulder pain and injury, including imaging and injections.

- Fresh frozen cadaver dissection lab: anatomy review
- Cadaveric shoulder stabilization surgery
- Multidisciplinary panel discussion

- Primary care assessment of shoulder pain/injury; red flags and imaging
- Therapeutic injections for the shoulder—who, when, why & how?
- Physiotherapy diagnosis and management of the stiff shoulder
- Rotator cuff-related shoulder pain
- Conservative vs. surgical management of the unstable shoulder
- Strength & motor control training for the shoulder girdle - evidence to inform rehabilitation

Exercise interventions and manual therapy techniques for common shoulder issues seen in clinic, including stiffness, hypermobility/instability and pain.
